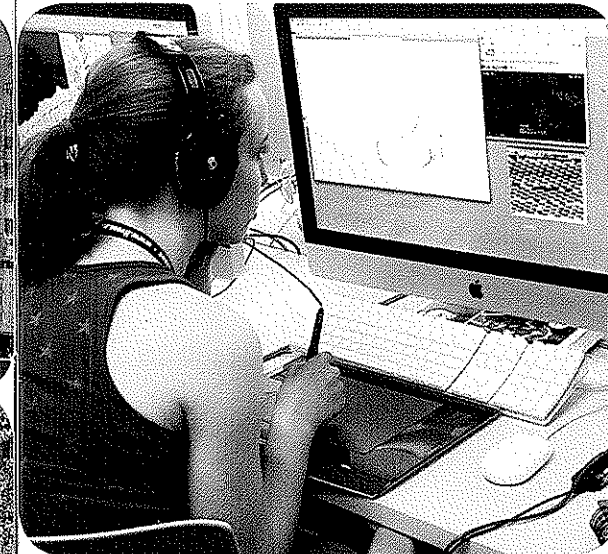
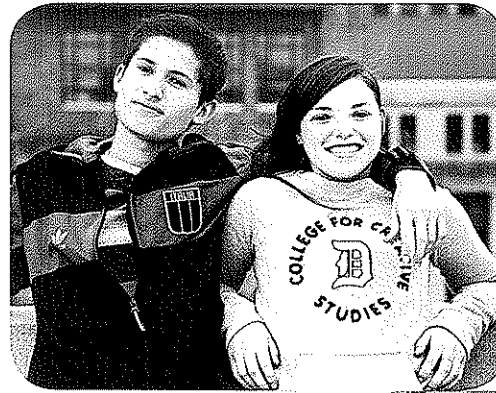

Meet guest artists and designers, including CCS alumni

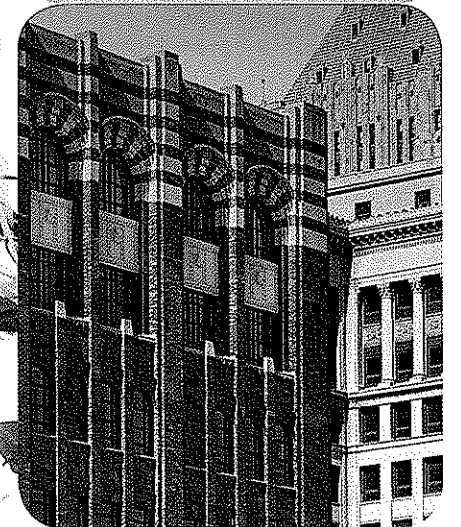
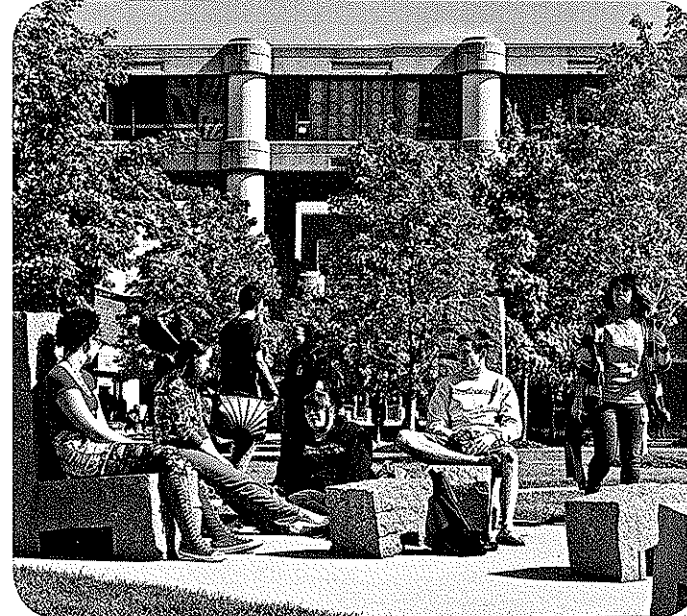

Step into something totally new – something you have never tried before, or enhance what you already know about your favorite subject. Choose a studio concentration and tackle a project. Study intensely for three weeks and create in a supportive and rigorous environment. You'll meet new people, have the option to live on campus, learn from professionals, receive feedback from admissions counselors and participate in a final exhibition of student work.

Through the CCS Precollege Summer Experience you will earn college credit, prepare for college-level work, develop your interests and talent, and build your portfolio.

ART SUPPLIES

PRECOLLEGE SUMMER EXPERIENCE NEED-BASED GRANTS

Students can see a copy of their grade report for free by going to Blackboard, bb.collegeforcreativestudies.edu, and selecting the Web Advisor tab. Transcripts of a student's course history are also available by online request for a fee of \$5. Requests must be made through Blackboard.
